IX. Presentation – Jason Marvel will present the FlowMSP software that uses Tier II data for use in pre-planning and incident responses. Critical Tier II and Hazmat information does not make its way to first responders all the time, and they are the ones who need it most. Right now, there is no mechanism for distributing information at the county or cross county levels. This software will allow first responders access to information about Tier II facilities and any extremely hazardous substances (EHS) used/stored at their facilities that was not accessible before.
